




Harris County Institute of Forensic Sciences is Hiring a Firearms Examiner

Applicant Requirements

- Bachelor of Science degree from an accredited institution with a major in Forensic Science, Chemistry, or related natural science
- College level statistics course
- Completed Firearms Examiner training program equivalent to the Association of Firearm and Tool Mark Examiners (AFTE) training manual or the National Firearms Examiner Academy (NFEA)
- Two (2) years of experience after completion of training and supervised casework
- Forensic Analyst Licensure by the Texas Forensic Science Commission within six (6) months of hire
- Association of Firearm and Tool Mark Examiners (AFTE) Certification within one (1) year of hire



Houston Area
